NOCTIS AT HÁBITAT VALÈNCIA 2026

Comfort evolves among new living scenarios, modularity, and innovation

From September 28th to October 1st, 2026, Noctis participates in Hábitat València, an international event dedicated to the world of furniture and design. The company presents a selection of designs that highlight its research journey and its ability to interpret new ways of experiencing home spaces.

At the center of the exhibition is a Camp configuration featuring the Folding Box® storage system, alongside the fixed Eddie H 10 and London with Folding Box® beds. These three distinct projects, each with unique aesthetics and features, are united by a vision of versatile comfort focused on functionality.

Camp: Noctis expands living boundaries

Camp is a modular project born from the collaboration between N-lab—Noctis's research and design center—and Studio d+a. This system marks a major milestone in the company's design journey, expanding its horizons beyond the traditional sleeping area to enter the living space and engage with an increasingly fluid, dynamic living concept.

Modularity and customization define its identity. The system is built on independent elements—panels, bed bases, sofa components, and integrable accessories—that can be freely combined to create ever-changing configurations capable of adapting to different spaces and lifestyles.

At Hábitat València, Camp will be presented in the H 32 version with the Folding Box® storage system, a space-optimizing solution that embodies Noctis's commitment to creating flexible, functional, and versatile furniture.

Eddie H 10: lightness and essentiality

Completing the setup, the Eddie H 10 bed boasts a minimal, essential character designed for contemporary spaces where design expresses itself through balance and formal cleanliness.

The slender base and sleek metal legs visually lighten the structure, creating an almost suspended effect. Defining the model is its bold headboard with a curved edge that frames and wraps around the soft padded cushion.

A discreet yet distinctive presence, also available in a Double version with two separate cushions, offering new stylistic possibilities and even more versatile comfort.

London and Folding Box®: functionality and attention to detail

Also on display is London with the Folding Box® storage system, reflecting one of Noctis's core focus areas: integrating practical space management into beds without compromising aesthetic quality.

Essential and refined, London features a comfortable high-density foam headboard and fully removable covers, allowing for broad customization. A key feature is the NZIP zipper on the headboard, available in 12 colors—a functional detail that becomes a decorative accent to suit various styles.

The presented model includes the patented Folding Box® system, featuring a easily foldable bottom panel that allows direct access to the floor underneath for convenient cleaning without moving or lifting the frame.

Participating in H abitat Val encia 2026 allows Noctis to showcase an ever-evolving vision of living: from the open, cross-functional Camp system to Eddie's formal lightness and London's functional intelligence with Folding Box®. Three offerings expressing one shared design philosophy: crafting spaces that adapt to people and evolve alongside them.

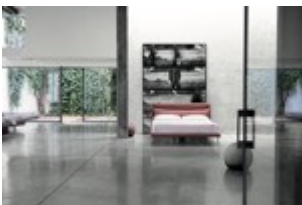
